

# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Williams Baptist College  
and

Shorter College

## PURPOSE

The purpose of this agreement is to assist students holding an Associate of Arts degree from Shorter College to transfer smoothly from Shorter College to Williams Baptist College. Through collaborative efforts, the partners hope to increase graduation rates, facilitate the transfer process, and foster greater collegiality in the intellectual marketplace of Arkansas.

## AGREEMENT


Satisfactory completion of an Associate of Arts degree designed for transfer will be accepted as satisfying the general education requirements of Williams Baptist College. (Note: All students – including transfer students – earning a baccalaureate degree at Williams must complete 6 hours of Bible.) This agreement does not address specific degree requirements outside of the General Education component, such as major or minor courses. Students should select those courses based on the specific degree requirements of Williams Baptist College. A student who holds an Associate of Arts degree with a 2.0 cumulative grade point average will be accepted for transfer subject to the following conditions:


1. The Associate of Arts degree must include the following:


A. English Composition	6 semester hours
B. Arts and Humanities (including speech)	12 semester hours
C. Math (College Algebra or above)	3 semester hours
D. Social Sciences	12 semester hours
E. Lab Sciences	8 semester hours
F. Physical Education	2 semester hours
<b>Total Core</b>	<b>43 semester hours</b>
<b>Elective (Minimum Number)</b>	<b>19 semester hours</b>
<b>TOTAL FOR A. A. (MINIMUM)</b>	<b>62 semester hours</b>


2. Remedial course grades will not be computed in the cumulative grade point average for purposes of admission to Williams Baptist College.
3. Courses taken to satisfy A. A. degree requirements must have a "C" or better in order to transfer.
4. Degree and program requirements (catalog rights) for students who transfer under this agreement will be determined in the same manner as if their initial enrollment had been at Williams Baptist College. All students at Williams – transfer students included – are required to complete two Bible courses prior to graduation.
5. Calculation of overall GPA for purposes of graduation and awarding of honors is left to the discretion of Williams Baptist College.
