SUMMARY, ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: This position facilitates learning for children, infants to 3 years old classroom. Teachers are required to use an approved developmentally appropriate curriculum which promotes routines, social, emotional, physical, and intellectual growth of children in the program. Our teachers must be able to teach, monitor, and supervise children utilizing prescribed educationally focused curriculum. Must be able to adapt to the needs of the children and the community, while maintaining and fostering positive and constructive interactions with children and parents. Ensure and maintain a safe and clean environment. Monitor children's progress and facilitate open communication with parents daily and through conferences. Understand and use school readiness to tie learning to parents and community needs. Consistently strives to meet all teacher responsibilities and the education of the children.
